## Play Options:

5. Alphabetize the Colony Name Cards.
6. Spell the Colony Names.
7. Put the timeline cards in order from the oldest explorations to the newest.
8. Put the timeline cards in order from the oldest settlements to the newest.

Note: We use the term “English” to signify the time before 1707 and “British” for the time after 1707 when England (with Wales) was unified with Scotland to form the Kingdom of Britain.
