Weaver

(weaves fabric)

Seamstress

(woman who sews clothes)

Tailor

(man who sews clothes)

Milliner

(gown maker, launder, lacemaker)

Hatter

(makes hats)

Wig maker

(makes wigs, often also a barber)

Cobbler

(shoemaker)

Basket weaver

(makes baskets and weaves the
seats for cane chairs)

Potter

(makes clay pots)

Cabinetmaker

(makes furniture)

Cooper

(barrel maker)

Chandler

(candlemaker)

Cutler

(makes and repairs knives)

Clockmaker

(makes and repairs clocks)

Silversmith

(makes items like tea sets out of silver)

Tinsmith_{or} Whitesmith

(makes items like candleholders out of tin)

Brass founder

(makes items like bells and shoe buckles out of brass)

Blacksmith

(shapes iron into tools and horseshoes)

Farrier

(shoes horses, often also a vet of sorts)

Tanner

(makes leather from rawhides)

Saddler

(crafts harnesses, saddles, and other leather items)

Gunsmith

(makes and repairs guns)

Wheelwright

(builds or mends wheels)

Miller

(grinds grain into flour)

Brickmaker

(crafts bricks from clay)

Wagonmaker

(makes wagons)
