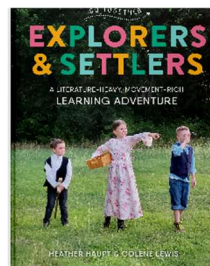

Play Options:

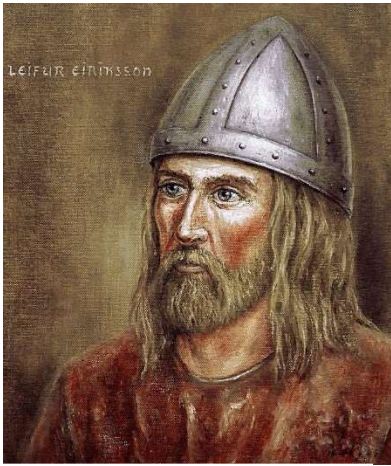
1. Read the Settler, Explorer, Event Cards out loud.
